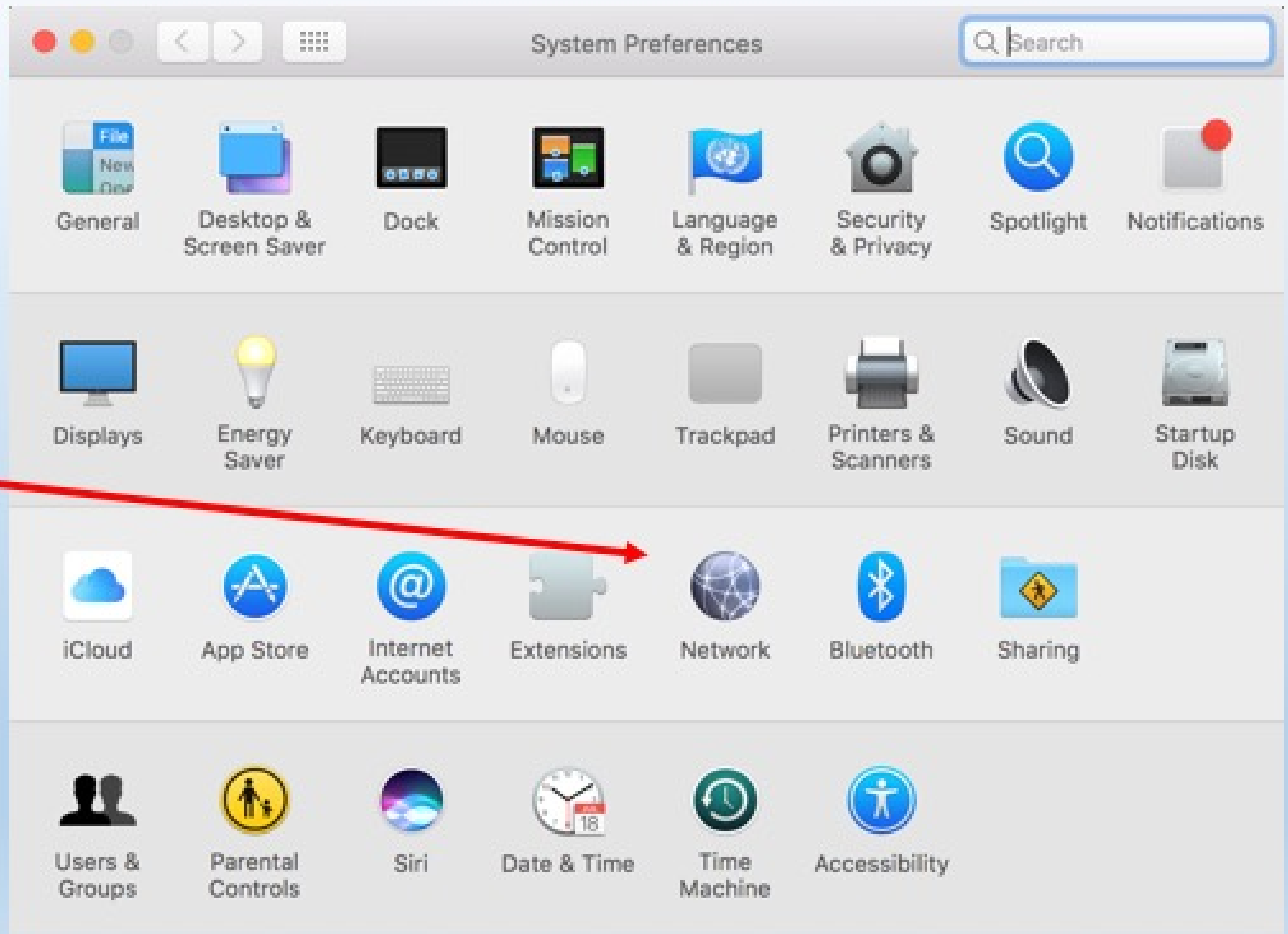


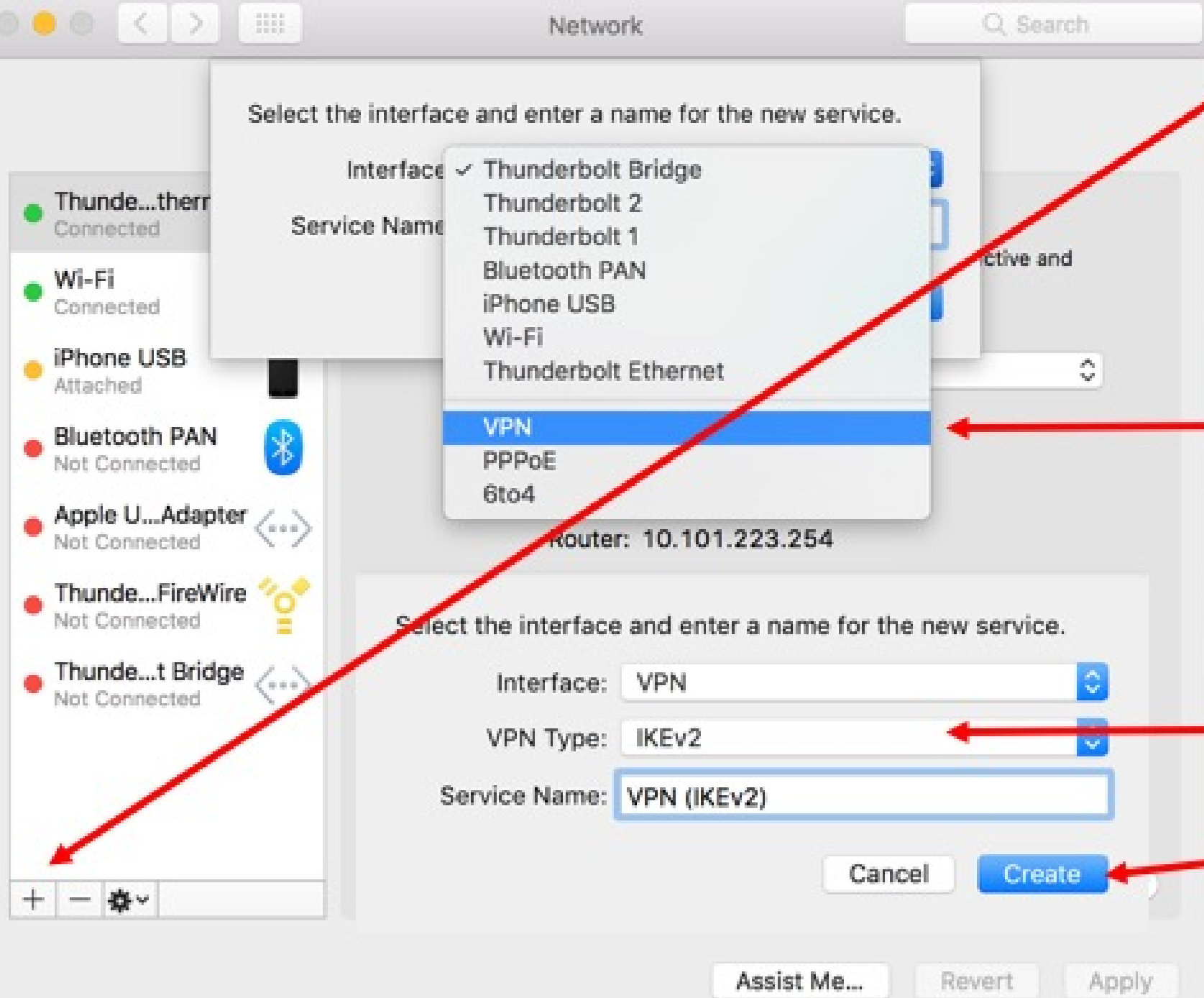
Open System Preferences.
